

ORDER CALLING GENERAL DIRECTORS' ELECTION
TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 6, 2018

STATE OF TEXAS }
COUNTY OF EL PASO }
LOWER VALLEY WATER DISTRICT }

WHEREAS, the Lower Valley Water District is a municipal utility district created by Legislature of the State of Texas pursuant to Article XVI, section 59 of the Texas Constitution, and pursuant to the Act of June 14, 1985, House Bill No. 2488, ch. 780, 1985 Tex. Sess. Laws 5611 (West), (hereafter the "Act") as amended by the Act of June 14, 1989, House Bill No. 3206, ch. 528, 1989 Tex. Gen. Laws, 1740 (West); and Act of May 23, 1995, House Bill No., 1600, ch. 206, Tex. Gen. Law, 1949;

WHEREAS, the creation of the District was confirmed by an election held for such purpose within the District on November 15, 1986;

WHEREAS, Section 49.103(b) of the Texas Water code requires that there shall be an election in either January or May of each even-numbered year to elect the appropriate number of Directors;

WHEREAS, Section 49.103(c) of the Texas Water Code permits, and the Board of Directors, on June 14, 1990 did assign position numbers to each director's office;

WHEREAS, the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA), found in 42 U.S.C. § 15481(a)(3), mandates that for elections in which a federal office is on the ballot, each polling place must be equipped with an electronic voting machine to facilitate voting by those with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature implemented HAVA in the 2003 regular session with the passage of House Bill 1549, but expanded the scope of the electronic voting machine requirement to apply to any election held in the state, with limited exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the federal Military and Overseas Voter Act of 2009 (MOVE Act), 42 U.S.C. § 1973ff-1, provides for an extended timetable in which absentee ballots must be transmitted to uniformed and overseas citizens at least 45 days prior to an election; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature implemented the MOVE Act in 2011 with the passage of Senate Bill 100, which overlaid the period between the state's primary and primary runoff election upon the most commonly-used uniform election date for the municipal general election, which is the second Saturday in May; and

WHEREAS, many counties in Texas concluded that, in even-numbered years (the years in which the state's primary and primary runoff elections are held), they will be unable to provide to their cities, through sharing, lease, or other means, the electronic voting machines that are required by the aforementioned federal and state laws; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Senate Bill 100 and other statutory and state constitutional provisions, the Lower Valley Water District did, through the adoption of an appropriate Resolution, modify its election procedures to be in compliance with Senate Bill 100 and other federal and state laws; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of The Lower Valley Water District, by resolution passed in August of 2012 did find in the best interests of the District and its citizens, and the pursuit of good government and did enact a Resolution to change the regular election date from May to the November Uniform election date; and

WHEREAS, it is required that an election be held in the District for the purpose of electing two directors to fill director positions for Place Nos. 1, 2 and 3 (each board position is a four-year term) as required by law; and

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF LOWER VALLEY WATER DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. An election shall be held within and over the entire Lower Valley Water District on November 6, 2018 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing directors to fill three director positions as required by law. The election shall be held in the regular county election precincts of El Paso County, Texas, to the extent that such precincts are within the boundaries of the District, as such precincts may be combined therein, at the at the polling places set forth in the Election Notice.

Section 2. Presiding Judges shall be appointed in accordance with the Texas Election Code. Presiding Judges may appoint two clerks to assist in conducting such election; one from each precinct shall be designated alternate presiding judge.

Section 3. Early Voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the Clint ISD Early College Academy, Administration Building, Room # 112, located at 13100 Alameda Ave., El Paso County, Texas 79836. Early Voting ballots for voting by mail may be obtained from and mailed to Lisa Wise, Elections Administrator, El Paso County Elections Department, 500 E. San Antonio, Suite #314, El Paso, Texas 79901. The Clerk for Early Voting shall keep the office open for early voting balloting by personal appearance for such purpose from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Clint ISD Early College Academy, Administration Building. The early voting schedule preceding the date of said election will be as as follows which is not an official state holiday and is subject to change.

Early voting shall take place beginning on Monday, October 22, 2018 and ending on Friday, November 2, 2018.

Early Voting Schedule:

Monday, October 22, 2018 – Friday, October 26, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
Saturday, October 27, 2018 – Sunday, October 28, 2018 from 12:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
Monday, October 29, 2018 – Friday, November 2, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Attached as **Exhibit A** is a list of all early voting stations provided by the El Paso County Elections Department. You may vote by personal appearance at any of these locations during the early voting period provided above.

Section 4. Such election shall be held and conducted and returns made to the Board of Directors of the District in accordance with applicable provisions of the Act, the Texas Election Code, as amended, the Texas Water Code, as amended, and this Order.


Section 5. The President and Secretary/Treasurer of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the days and place for holding such election and of the proposition to be voted on by publishing such notice once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the District, the first publication to be at least fourteen (14) days prior to the day set forth for such election.

Section 6. The President and Secretary/Treasurer are authorized on behalf of the Board to evidence adoption of this Order and to do any and all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding of such election and to give effect to the intent to this Order.

Section 7. A copy of this Order shall constitute and serve as proper notice of said election, and a copy of this Order shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the District, with the first publication to be at least fourteen days before the date set for the election.

Section 8. If any provision, section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Order is held for any reason to be invalid, such invalid portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Order.
