

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR) Failure to Report Monitoring Events to the State that are Not Related to *E. coli*-positive Sample Results – Template 3-5

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

#### Reporting Requirement(s) Not Met for [Lower Valley Water District]

We are required to report the results of monitoring of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During **6/2016, 9/2016, 3/2017, and 7/2018** we did not report the results of monitoring for total coliform.

Our system failed to notify the state drinking water program as required by **6/2016, 9/2016, 3/2017, and 7/2018**. Although public health was not impacted, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

#### What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

#### What is being done?

The Lower Valley Water District (LVWD) abide by the Standardized Operating Procedures that are established and registered with The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under the RTCR plan. The LVWD certified water technician re-collected samples from the location(s) in question along with 1 downstream and 1 upstream additional samples that are within 5 connections of location(s) in question. The samples were then submitted to a State certified lab resulted as negative.

The LVWD continuously monitors the water quality we provide you our customers, by following the strict guidelines provided by TCEQ and the EPA.
