**Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation  
Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)  
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The **Lower Valley Water District** water system PWS ID **0710154** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This/These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter October, November, December 2019.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

Lower Valley Water District resubmitted its Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report – 4<sup>th</sup>.

The District continues to sample designated sites for residuals monthly, and will follow up with TCEQ on our Districts DLQOR.
